A RESOLUTION TO UPDATE RULES FOR COUNCIL MEETINGS

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Powhatan Point, Ohio, desires to establish and update rules for the efficient management of meetings of Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF POWHATAN POINT, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I: Any member of the public desiring to be heard before Council or to introduce any business before Council, must notify the Clerk by the end of the business day before the Regular or Special council meeting in order to be placed on the agenda for the meeting and shall provide the Clerk with the subject matter of their comments or business.

SECTION II: The Mayor or Presiding Officer may at their discretion recognize members of the public without prior notification.

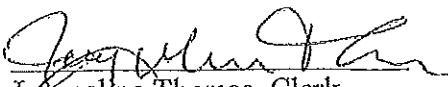
SECTION III: Discussion by any individual shall be limited to five minutes, or longer at the discretion of the Mayor or Presiding Officer or Council by vote of a majority of those present.

SECTION IV: Any group of four or more, or a delegation of four or more, wishing to appear before Council shall notify the Clerk by the end of the business day before to the Regular or Special council meeting. Said group or delegation shall choose a spokesperson to initially present the issue to Council, and then other members of the group may be recognized to give comments directly related to the issue when the group has been recognized to speak on the committee topic.

SECTION V: At all times, speakers must be civil and courteous. In the event speakers or guests become unruly, a five-minute recess may be declared by the Mayor or Presiding Officer. Speakers may be escorted outside and be brought back into the council chambers one at a time to present their comments.

SECTION VI: Prior to every council meeting, members of the public shall sign in on the provided sign-in sheet with their name, contact information, and, if applicable, the subject on which they will be speaking.
